

3 Day Kakadu and Katherine Adventure Darwin to Darwin



Discover spectacular waterways and gorges and learn about Aboriginal rock art and culture. Get a taste of the Top End as you explore Kakadu and Nitmiluk National Parks.

Day 1: Darwin to Kakadu National Park (243km)

Collect your Avis vehicle by 8am this morning. Depart Darwin and continue along to Jabiru in the World Heritage Listed Kakadu National Park. Birdwatchers and nature lovers should stop along the way at the Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve, Window on the Wetlands Visitor Centre. Arrive into Jabiru by lunchtime. This afternoon travel to the East Alligator River where you will join a Gulyambi River Cruise and enjoy an informative Aboriginal Cultural tour on one of Kakadu National Park's most spectacular waterways. Overnight at Gagudju Crocodile Holiday Inn.

Day 2: Kakadu National Park to Katherine (285km)

Spend the morning exploring Nourlangie Rock, a famous Aboriginal rock art site. Visit the Warradjian Aboriginal Cultural Centre where you will learn about the culture and beliefs of the traditional Aboriginal people. Depart Kakadu and head south towards Pine Creek and to Katherine. This afternoon you will have the chance to explore Katherine at leisure. Overnight at All Seasons Katherine.

Day 3: Katherine to Darwin (309km)

Travel to spectacular Katherine Gorge located

30 kilometres from Katherine. This morning you are booked on a four hour cruise through three gorges in the spectacular Nitmiluk National Park. After the cruise visit the Nitmiluk Visitor Centre to learn more about this fascinating area. Head back to Darwin this afternoon on a leisurely 3½ hour drive. The rental car is available until the following day. Return the car at the airport or city depot by the same time as it was collected on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

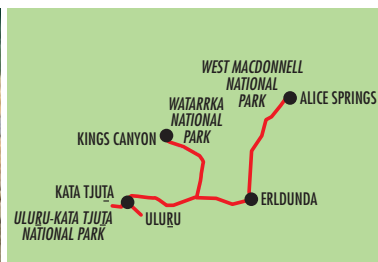

4 Day Red Centre Discovery Alice Springs to Uluru



Discover the natural wonders of the Red Centre and the remote outback town of Alice Springs, the heart of the Northern Territory.

Day 1: Alice Springs

Collect your Avis vehicle early and explore this beautiful part of the Outback. Why not visit the Old Telegraph Station, the Aviation Museum and the original Royal Flying Doctor Service? (own expense). Tonight enjoy a traditional performance at Red Centre Dreaming. Overnight at Aurora Alice Springs.

Day 2: Alice Springs to Kings Canyon (476km)

Travel to Kings Canyon today and en route pass the Henbury Meteorite craters, formed around 4700 years ago. Continue to Voyages Kings Canyon Resort. Walk the rim of the canyon and gaze 300m down to the valley floor. Sandstone walls frame the 'Garden of Eden', a unique waterhole surrounded by palms and

ferns. Overnight at Voyages Kings Canyon Resort.

Day 3: Kings Canyon to Uluru (318km)

Travel to spectacular Yulara and see the world's greatest monolith, Uluru and also Kata Tjuta (Olgas). On arrival check-in to your hotel. This afternoon learn about the region's history, unique flora and fauna, how the earth created such remarkable landmarks and how the Aboriginal communities have lived and thrived here for thousands of years. Later take a trip out to the famous 'sunset strip' to see the sun

setting over Ayers Rock. Overnight at Voyages Outback Pioneer Hotel.

Day 4: Uluru

This morning is at leisure to explore. Perhaps rise early and experience the beautiful sunrise over Ayers Rock or take a walk into the majestic Olga Gorge. Return the car off at the airport today by the same time as it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

6 Day Red Centre Way Alice Springs to Alice Springs



Through the ancient heart of the Australian outback, the Red Centre Way navigates through Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park, Kings Canyon, the West MacDonnell Ranges and Alice Springs by 4WD.

Day 1: Alice Springs

Collect your Avis vehicle early and spend a full day exploring Alice Springs. Tonight enjoy a traditional Aboriginal performance with dinner at Red Centre Dreaming. Overnight at Aurora Alice Springs.

Day 2: Alice Springs to Glen Helen (130km)

Depart Alice Springs and head west following the spectacular MacDonnell Ranges. Along the way visit Simpsons Gap, Standley Chasm and Ellery Creek Gorges. Overnight at Glen Helen Resort.

Day 3: Glen Helen to Kings Canyon (260km)

Depart Glen Helen for some real outback four wheel driving on the Mereenie Loop to Kings Canyon. Stop at Redbank Gorge and Tnorala (Gosse Bluff) Conservation Reserve along the way. Overnight at Voyages Kings Canyon Resort.

Day 4: Kings Canyon to Uluru (300km)

Why not start the morning with a Kings Canyon walk before departing for Uluru and Ayers Rock Resort. Head to 'the strip' to see a famous Uluru sunset. Overnight at Voyages Outback Pioneer Hotel.

Day 5: Uluru and Kata Tjuta

Today is free to explore all that this stunning area has to offer. Perhaps watch the sun rise over Uluru, then travel on to see the domes of Kata Tjuta and stay for sunset. Overnight at Voyages Outback Pioneer Hotel.

Day 6: Uluru to Alice Springs (443km)

This afternoon take the return trip to Alice Springs stopping at Rainbow Valley, a massive sandstone formation of coloured bands. Return the vehicle this afternoon or the following day by the same time it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

6 Day Top End Discovery Darwin to Darwin



Waterfalls, rock art and culture. Discover this enchanted land as you meander through World Heritage Listed Kakadu National Park, Litchfield National Park and Nitmiluk National Park.

Day 1: Darwin to Kakadu National Park (243km)

Depart Darwin for Jabiru, located in the World Heritage Listed Kakadu National Park. Birdwatchers and nature lovers should stop along the way at the Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve, Window on the Wetlands Visitor Centre. Stop just outside Jabiru and visit the Bowali Visitor Centre Park Headquarters. Stop at the interpretive centre to gain a greater understanding of Kakadu's landscape and moods. Overnight at Gagudju Crocodile Holiday Inn.

Day 2: Kakadu National Park

This morning travel to the East Alligator River for a Gulyambi River Cruise. Enjoy an informative Aboriginal Cultural tour on one of Kakadu National Park's most spectacular waterways. Continue on to Ubirr, an Aboriginal rock art site that also provides 360 degree views of the surrounding wetlands. Visit Nourlangie Rock and take a self-guided walk around the ancient rock art galleries. Overnight at Gagudju Crocodile Holiday Inn.

Day 3: Kakadu National Park to Katherine (285km)

Depart Jabiru early this morning and head south towards Pine Creek and on to Katherine. This afternoon travel to spectacular Katherine Gorge in Nitmiluk National Park. Visit the Nitmiluk Visitor Centre to learn more about this fascinating area before enjoying a two hour gorge cruise. Overnight at All Seasons Katherine.

Day 4: Katherine

Spend the day exploring Katherine's attractions. Learn about Katherine's early history at the Katherine Museum or School of the Air. Travel

north to the town of Mataranka, best known for its 34 degree thermal pool. The crystal clear water of Mataranka Thermal Pool is surrounded by the lush tropical forest of Eley National Park. Overnight at All Seasons Katherine.

Day 5: Katherine to Litchfield National Park (227km)

This morning drive north and enjoy a full day in Litchfield National Park. Litchfield is the Top End's most accessible natural attraction and offers swimming and spectacular waterfalls year round. Some of the attractions include Buley Rockhole, Wangi and Florence Falls. Overnight at Best Western Batchelor Resort.

Day 6: Litchfield National Park to Darwin (113km)

Enjoy more time in Litchfield National Park before returning to Darwin. Stop at Territory Wildlife Park and take your time to enjoy this 400 hectare park. Return the car this afternoon or the following morning by the same time it was collected on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

Day 2: Uluru

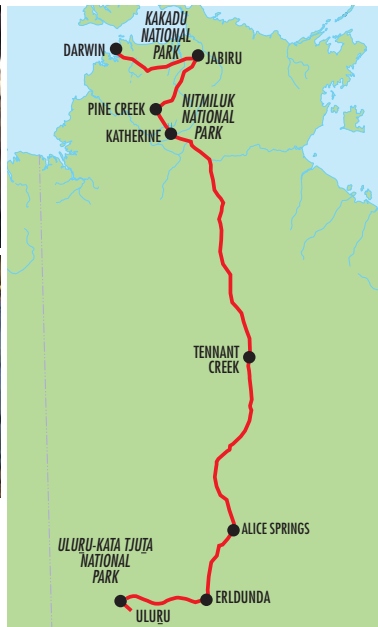

Day 7: Kakadu National Park

This morning travel to the East Alligator River for a Gulyambi River Cruise and enjoy an informative Aboriginal Cultural tour.
