2 Day Kangaroo Island Self Drive Explorer



Kangaroo Island is Australia's third largest island and offers a holiday that can be full of excitement and surprises, or as peaceful and relaxing as you choose. Stay in the pre-booked accommodation of your choice and explore the island over two days or longer.

Day 1: Early morning coach transfer from your Adelaide hotel to Cape Jervis where SeaLink's large and comfortable ferry will cruise to Kangaroo Island in just 45 minutes. You will be met by a car rental representative with your hire car.

Over the next two days explore the island where driving is pleasurable – no traffic lights! Visit Flinders Chase National Park to

see Remarkable Rocks and Admirals Arch. Don't go past Seal Bay where you can take a guided beach walk among a colony of rare Australian sea lions. Drop into Vivonne Bay and Little Sahara where pure white sand dunes rise amidst the bushland.

Other attractions include honey and lavender farms, a eucalyptus oil distillery and a sheep dairy where you'll taste the most amazing cheeses and yoghurt. Enjoy the fine food and wine produced on Kangaroo Island, or for the more adventurous, go sandboarding, scuba diving, fishing, surfing or bushwalking.

Day 2: After another day of exploring, make your way to the Penneshaw Wharf to board your return SeaLink ferry and coach transfer to Adelaide. (B)

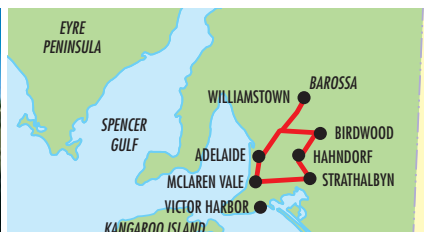

4 Day Vineyard Explorer Adelaide to Adelaide



Delight in some of the most famous wine producing vineyards in Australia.

Day 1: Adelaide to Barossa (74km)

Collect your Avis vehicle and Cellar Door Pass to commence your vineyard explorer. The pass gives you fantastic discounts and a guide to local vineyards as well as access to premium wine tastings and winery tours. Travel via the Chain of Ponds to the Barossa. Overnight at Novotel Barossa Valley Resort.

Day 2: Barossa

World famous Barossa Shiraz and Eden Valley Riesling plus other premium wines, regional produce and acclaimed restaurants make this one of Australia's most significant wine regions. The Barossa is also home of some of the most well known wine producers such as Penfolds Barossa, Saltram Wine

Estate, Wolf Blass and Jacob's Creek. Overnight at Novotel Barossa Valley Resort.

Day 3: Barossa to McLaren Vale (180km)

Travel this morning through the Adelaide Hills to explore some of the 33 cellar doors and vineyards in the region and the many orchards to sample fresh fruits. The oldest surviving German Settlement in Australia, Hahndorf is a must visit, where a strong German flavour still exists in the town today. Sample traditional small goods or visit one of the German bakeries that line the main street. Continue onto Strathalbyn, a pretty town with many galleries, antique stores, historic architecture and cafés, perfect for an afternoon break, before arriving at

McLaren Vale. Overnight at McLaren Vale Motel & Apartments.

Day 4: McLaren Vale to Adelaide (40km)

Enjoy a leisurely day exploring the Fleurieu Peninsula's most famous wine region, McLaren Vale, known for its Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Grenache, Merlot and Chardonnay. The region produces exceptional wines, fruits, olives and almonds. Take your time returning to Adelaide. The car is booked until the following day and should be returned to either the city or airport depot by the same time as it was picked up on day 1 to avoid any additional charges. (B)

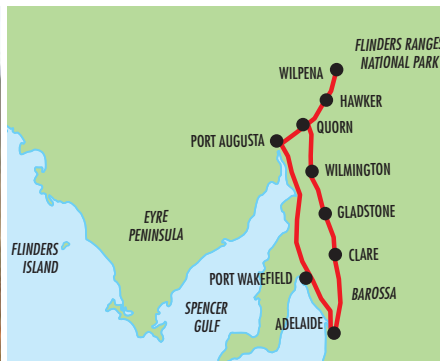

4 Day Flinders Ranges Adelaide to Adelaide



Discover nature on a grand scale in the magnificent Flinders Ranges.

Day 1: Adelaide to Port Augusta (308km)

Collect your Avis vehicle and follow Port Wakefield Road along York Peninsula. Pass through the historic towns of Two Wells and Dublin before arriving at Port Wakefield, access into the southern Flinders Ranges. Continue north to Port Augusta and take the opportunity to visit the Wadlata Ouback Interpretive Centre. Overnight at Majestic Oasis Apartments.

Day 2: Port Augusta to Wilpena Pound (120km)

This morning visit the Royal Flying Doctor Service before travelling on to Quorn, home to the much loved Pichi Richi Railway. Continue on through Hawker to the magnificent Wilpena Pound. Overnight at Wilpena Pound Resort.

Day 3: Wilpena Pound

A full day to explore this majestic, timeless landscape of mountain scenery and peaceful tree-lined gorges.

Enjoy a leisurely bush walk or a stunning ridge top drive. Take an organised 4WD tour or a breathtaking scenic flight (extra charge). Overnight at Wilpena Pound Resort.

Day 4: Wilpena Pound to Adelaide (397km)

Depart early and travel through the historic towns of Wilmington and Gladstone. Explore the heritage listed Gladstone Gaol, one of the region's major attractions. Continue on to Clare and stop along the way at some of the many cellar doors. Journey at leisure on to Adelaide. The car is booked until the following day and should be returned to either the city or airport depot by the same time it was picked up on day 1 to avoid any additional charges.
