

2 Day Man from Snowy River Horse Ride



Day 1: Man from Snowy River horse riding trail

Depart Melbourne early morning, stopping for a hearty country morning tea before arriving at a high country farming property. After saddling up, set off on the 'Man from Snowy River' experience on horseback. Locals guide us to spectacular 360 degree views, and then see the perilously steep hill where the famous jump scene from the movie was filmed. Along the way, watch out for the wildlife including kangaroos, wallabies and Australia's largest bird of flight, the wedge tail eagle. Stop for lunch, enjoying a gourmet hamper on Kate Cameron's peak, and then descend the bridle tracks through quiet valleys and points of rich historical interest. Arrive at the celebrated River House at Howqua Dale, a magnificent country house hotel on the banks of the Howqua River, with beautiful views of the garden or countryside from all rooms. Dinner tonight is a riverside barbecue in one of Victoria's prettiest valleys. (LD)

Day 2: Man from Snowy River horse riding trail

Enjoy a famous country breakfast and set off along the mountain cattlemen's tracks through creeks and gullies to Dungeon Hut for lunch and stories of high country legends. There is more spectacular scenery to come

this afternoon before arriving back at the stables at around 3pm for some traditional, warm Australian hospitality in the farmhouse before your return transfer back to Melbourne. (BL)

3 Day Walk and Tour the Great Ocean Road

Day 1: Melbourne to Port Campbell

Travel by bus to the seaside town of Port Campbell and check in at Portside for your overnight accommodation. At sunset, have the option of visiting the nearby Twelve Apostles and possibly spotting little penguins coming ashore. Enjoy dinner this evening at Waves Restaurant. (D)

Day 2: Great Ocean Road Walk

After breakfast, depart Port Campbell for a drive along the Great Ocean Road. Begin your Great Ocean Walk between Melanesia Beach and Moonlight Head. After a 2.5 hour walk, enjoy a lunch break at scenic Ryans Den, before continuing the walk to Moonlight Head to meet the bus back to Port Campbell. Stop along the way at the old General store at Princetown, overlooking the Gellibrand River, for a well earned tea or coffee. Arrive back at Port Campbell where you will dine at Waves Restaurant later that evening. (BLD)

Day 3: Port Campbell to Melbourne

After breakfast visit Loch Ard Gorge to learn the history of Loch Ard shipwreck. Continue on to the Twelve Apostles, followed by a lunch stop at Apollo Bay. Visit the picturesque beachside towns of Lorne and Torquay and famous Bells Beach before arriving to Melbourne in the evening. (B)

4 Day Great Walhalla Alpine Trail

Join in around the campfire for a hearty dinner. (BLD)

Day 3: Baw Baw National Park to Walhalla

This morning, break camp to descend to O'Sheas Mill site and Poverty Point on the Thomson River with a lunch by the banks of the crystal clear Thomson River.

In the afternoon arrive back to Walhalla historic township for your overnight accommodation and dinner. (BLD)
