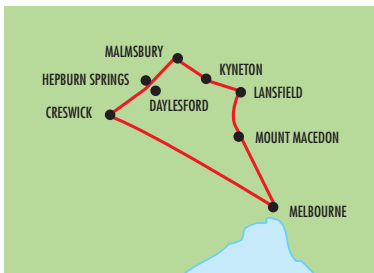

## 2 or 3 Day Pure Indulgence Melbourne to Melbourne



Wind down, indulge, and soak up the peaceful atmosphere of Victoria's Spa Country.

### Day 1: Melbourne to Hepburn Springs (118km)

Collect your Avis vehicle and travel north-west from Melbourne to Daylesford and Hepburn Springs. Visit the heart of Spa Country, home to Australia's largest concentration of naturally occurring mineral springs. Indulge in soothing and pampering treatments at one of the many day spas in the area (own expense). Along the main street of Daylesford are great cafés, restaurants and pubs. For the ultimate in culinary excellence, dine at the Lake House Restaurant with lovely views in a peaceful lakeside setting.

For a leisurely afternoon, browse through the many antique stores and galleries including the Convent Gallery at Daylesford, or visit the Lavandula

Swiss Italian Farm, just north of Daylesford. Overnight at Peppers Springs Retreat & Spa.

### Day 2: Hepburn Springs to Melbourne (140km)

Drive through the townships of Malmesbury, Kyneton and Lancefield to Mount Macedon, or travel via historic Kilmore, Victoria's oldest inland settled town, all the while taking time to enjoy the historic bluestone buildings, botanical gardens, antique shops and galleries. Arriving at Mount Macedon, wander around the stunning 19th century gardens and explore the natural beauty of the area. The Memorial Cross

at Mount Macedon and Camels Hump Lookout are highlights not to be missed.

Make your way back to Melbourne via Woodend and Trentham. Take in the natural attractions such as the mysterious Hanging Rock and Trentham Falls, Lerderderg State Park and Werribee Gorge State Park. The car is booked until the following day and should be returned to either the city or airport depot by the same time as it was picked up on day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

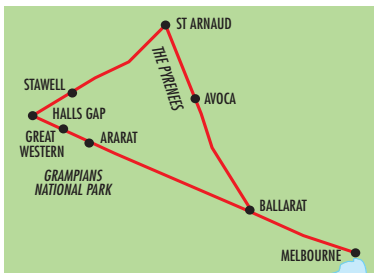

## 3 Day Great Grape Road Melbourne to Melbourne



Tour the scenic circuit of the Pyrenees, Grampians and Ballarat wine regions of Western Victoria.

### Day 1: Melbourne to Halls Gap (261km)

Collect your Avis vehicle and travel to the Grampians wine region via Ballarat. The region has some of the oldest Shiraz vines in the world and is best known for table wines, Shiraz, Riesling, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. The scenic countryside around Ararat, Buangor, Great Western and Halls Gap is home to some outstanding wineries such as historic Seppelt and Best's Great Western and newer vineyards such as Mt Langi Ghiran and Montara. Grampian wines are known for their strong berry flavours and soft tannins. Overnight at Halls Gap Colonial Motor Inn.

### Day 2: Halls Gap to Ballarat via the Pyrenees Wine Region (236km)

After leaving the mountainous terrain of the Grampians, the Great Grape Road swings east to the Pyrenees, a splendid back drop for a tasting at the region's 12 excellent wineries, specialising in spicy reds in particular and also Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc. Sample some of the region's local delicacies including olive oil, lamb and smoked trout. Continue onto Ballarat and stop off at additional wineries along the way. Overnight at Mercure Ballarat Hotel & Convention Centre.

### Day 3: Ballarat to Melbourne (112km)

Ballarat, a historic town with a colourful gold mining past is quickly gaining reputation for its subtly fragrant Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, sparkling wines and quality local produce. Explore Ballarat's rich history, heritage and ornate Victorian buildings. Perhaps visit Sovereign Hill, an outdoor museum re-creating the gold rush era. Journey at leisure back to Melbourne. The car is booked until the following day and should be returned to either the city or airport depot by the same time as it was picked up on day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

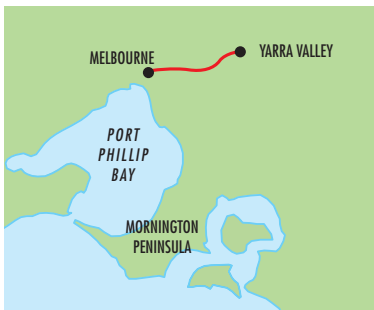

## 3 Day Yarra Valley Melbourne to Melbourne



Explore over 55 wineries in Victoria's most famous wine growing region.

### Day 1: Melbourne to Yarra Valley (52km)

Collect your Avis vehicle and Cellar Door Pass and travel to the Yarra Valley via Melbourne's eastern suburbs. The Yarra Valley is recognised as one of the world's great wine growing regions for Pinot Noir and sparkling wines. Numerous wineries offer cellar door tastings, sales and restaurants serving gourmet food. The region's iconic wineries include De Bortoli, Fergusson, Yering Station, Domaine Chandon and Coldstream Hills. The Cellar Door Pass gives you fantastic discounts and a guide to local vineyards and access to premium wine tastings and tours. Overnight at The Sebel Heritage Yarra Valley.

### Day 2: Yarra Valley

Spend the day at leisure and further explore the Yarra Valley. Follow the Yarra Valley Food and Wine Trail, visit the Yarra Valley Dairy or travel through some of Victoria's most scenic touring routes to the Dandenong Ranges. If it's a more relaxing day you prefer, play a round of golf of the Sebel Heritage Yarra Valley's championship course, or be pampered at the Heritage Day Spa (own expense). Overnight at The Sebel Heritage Yarra Valley.

### Day 3: Yarra Valley to Melbourne (52km)

Start the morning with a different view of the valley and take to the skies in a hot air balloon before gently descending into a vineyard to enjoy breakfast (own expense). Complete your experience and get close to Australian Wildlife at Healesville Sanctuary, home to over 200 species of native birds and animals (own expense). Take your time returning to Melbourne.
